RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration for the use of the JBSA-Camp Bullis Outdoor Recreation Program, I hereby release from liability and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the United States of America (hereinafter referred to as the United States), its officers, agents, employees, and non-appropriated fund instrumentalities, from and against any and all suits, claims, demands or actions, liabilities, judgments, costs, and attorneys' fees arising out of, or in any manner predicated upon personal injury, property damage, or death resulting from, related to, caused by, or arising out of participation by me, my minor child, or other guests of mine in use of the facility or any activity conducted in relation thereto, including damages to the property of the United States, or of third parties.

I understand that the area I am being allowed to enter is used for military training. I understand that in allowing me to enter areas of JBSA-Camp Bullis, the United States is not representing such area free of man-made hazards. Therefore, I understand that my safety, my child's safety, and the safety of other guests of mine requires that I remain vigilant.

I also recognize and understand there are additional inherent risks associated with hunting, to include personal injury, property damage, and even death. I understand that said activity could involve falling trees, animal attacks, firearms, other weapons, motor vehicles, and other items and activities that have a high probability of causing harm. I also recognize that my acts and the acts of other individuals, through negligence, recklessness, or otherwise, could cause personal injury, property damage, or even death. I acknowledge that I, my child, and other guest of mine are voluntarily participating in hunting with a full understanding and appreciation of the potential dangers.

JBSA-CAMP BULLIS HUNTING SAFETY BRIEF

It is each Hunter's Responsibility to know and understand all rules and regulations associated with the Hunting Program at JBSA - Camp Bullis. Personnel at the Rod-N-Gun Recreation Center (RNGRC) will be Checking-in and Checking-out, or for providing information pertaining to the Hunting Program.

1. Entering any Training Area (TA) without checking-in and obtaining a windshield card is considered trespassing. Card must be placed so that it is visible in front windshield.
2. Alcohol will not be consumed or prior to, or in conjunction with the hunts at JBSA-Camp Bullis. Possession of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
3. NO firearms, except shotgun, are allowed. All shotguns must be registered with RNGRC prior to first use per annual JBSA hunting season.
4. Please keep us informed and updated at the RNGRC if you harvest an animal, call (210) 295-7577 or (210) 295-7529.
5. Speed limit is 30 MPH unless otherwise posted.
6. Vehicles may only be driven on paved roads and graveled trails. Individuals who get stuck in the field will be responsible for the off-road recovery of their own vehicles, government assets will not be used to recover personally owned vehicles."
7. Vehicles will be parked immediately adjacent to the nearest roadway or trail, in a manner which does not restrict travel on the road or trail. Do not pull into the grass to park.
8. You must drive directly to and from your selected area and remain in your area at all times. If you are tracking and the animal has entered another area call RNGRC for directions.
9. Field dress all animals before returning to the RNGRC building 6215.
10. If you get lost or stranded, remain in place and call the RNGRC.
11. If Troops are present in the area, unload weapon and leave, and return to Building 6215.
12. DO NOT be late for checkout. Limit tracking time to 30 minutes. If not found return to or call RNGRC for further instructions.

I have read and understand the contents of JBSA-Camp Bullis Hunting Regulations. I understand that failure to comply with the JBSA-Camp Bullis Hunting Regulations may result in suspension from participating in the hunting program.
